This year's event is Saturday, November 18, 2023, with the parade starting at 5:30 p.m. The festivities feature the only light parade in the City, along with entertainment by local performers and shopping opportunities with local vendors.

Parade Entry Limitations- 55 Parade Entries

- 1. Car clubs will have a limit of 5 entries, with a max of 9 vehicles per club.
- 2. Walking groups are limited to 8 entries with a max of 100 walkers per entry.
- 3. Walking groups associated with a float do not count towards the 8 limit entries but the number of walkers is limited to 25 per entry.

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Float Safety Requirements

1. CHASSIS Flexible enough to withstand normal driving, but rigid enough not to oscillate under normal

driving conditions.

2. BRAKE SYSTEM Must be hydraulic and have an emergency brake system, and each must be in good working

condition.

3. WHEELS & TIRES Must be in good working condition and able to perform normal steering functions with no more

than one-half round play.

4. ENGINE Must be properly installed and in good working condition.

5. COOLING SYSTEM Must be sufficient to cool the engine and ensure proper sir flow to the radiator.

6. EXHAUST SYSTEMMust meet automotive standards, free of cracks. Should extend 12" beyond the exterior of float.

Must be insulated with pipe lagging and must not make contact with the float. Flexible exhaust

pipe tubing must extend 12" to the side or rear of the float beyond the apron.

7. MUFFLER Clear of running gear; if near combustible objects, it must be shielded.

8. FUEL SYSTEMGas tanks must be D.O.T. approved for vehicle use. The tank should be securely mounted to

frame and accessible, mounted away from driver position. The tank be free of decorations.

9. FIRE WALLSMust be left intact or reasonable metal substitute must be provided.

10. ELECTRICAL SYSTEMApproved wiring for automotive use. Installation must minimize mechanical damage and must

be properly fused. Circuits above 30 volts must be ungrounded.

11. STEERING Must be in good working condition and able to perform normal steering functions with no more

than one-half round play.

12. TOWING Floats must be equipped with some type of proper towing device on the front and rear of float.

13. FIRE EXTINGUISHER Dry chemical-all-purpose 2a-10bc extinguisher is required. Extinguisher should be tested and

certified and be easily accessible to the driver. No smoking will be permitted on or near floats, including the assembly area.

14. DRIVER SPACE Interior should adequately permit emergency escape. Two exits for both driver and inspector

should be available.

15. VENTILATION Must provide adequate ventilation for possible exhaust leaks.

16. DRIVER VISIBILITY Adequate visibility should be provided. Devices such as mirrors will not be allowed. Riders should

not block driver visibility.

17. RIDER PROTECTION Each float rider will be provided with means to support and protect themselves against falling.

(examples: seat belts, back support, armrests or hand holds) Riders should only be used when they serve a useful function and must be costumed appropriately to fit the float title, and safely fit the float tile and safely for visibility, and secure footing or seating. Under no circumstances should materials or objects of any kind be thrown or otherwise distributed from riders on the

float during the parade route. Intoxicants will not be allowed on the floats.

18. PORTABLE GENERATORSGenerators are allowed but must be securely mounted on the vehicle and allow a 12" minimum

spacing between generators and combustibles. Generators must be equipped with exhaust lines firmly attached and installed so as to terminate into a common exhaust line serving the vehicle or piped directly to exterior of float as required for the vehicle exhaust system.

(Recommend use of GFCI Outlet).

19. HYDRAULIC SYSTEMS Are allowed. Must have mechanical locks and override.

20. DECORATIONS Decorative materials must be fire retardant.

Rules and Regulations

- Entries for the parade are limited to the first 55 paid parade entries. Registration forms are considered on a first paid basis. Please ensure all forms are filled out completely. The signed waiver of liability form and all other required forms must accompany the registration. Registrations will not be accepted without all the required material. (Initial ___)
 Floats and entries may be no more than 14 feet high, 35 feet long, and 20 feet wide to allow for safe maneuvering under traffic lights and turning streets. Forms must have proper measurements of vehicle and walkers the total length and width. (Initial ___)
 Person driving the float must present proof of insurance and current and valid state-issued Driver's License. A copy of each will be
- obtained at first mandatory meeting. (Initial ___)

 4. All entries must have excessive lights to highlight their entry. For example, a car should have 25 strands or more of lights or 'net' packages to cover more space. Rope lighting and spotlights could be used for outlining. Floats, trailers, bikes, and marching/walking groups are required to have some source of lighting. Power sources are generators, battery adapters, power converters and battery operated accessories. Designated El Paso Parks and Recreation Department personnel will be in the vicinity to inspect entries prior to the parade. If it is, determined that more lights are required the entry may be disqualified from the parade and fee is non- refundable. People walking must be individually lighted from the waist up. (Initial ___)
- 5. Headlights must be covered or off during the parade route. (Initial ___)
- 6. All walking, marching and performance groups must stay in constant motion to avoid delays. Parade escorts will ensure constant forward motion of the parade and will maintain a steady rate to prevent gaps. Please do not stop and perform along the parade route. Skits, maneuvers or other type of performances are not permitted. (Initial ___)
- 7. For the safety of parade participants and spectators: No candy, flyers, silly string, coupons, books, balloons, toys or objects may be thrown by parade participants and no fire or pyrotechnics. The firing of firearms of any kind is prohibited. City Code 10.12.010. A licensed carrier must notify coordinator (blank ammunition only). (Initial ____)
- 8. All music played maybe Holiday themed rap, house, hard rock, and hip-hop. No other, or unrelated to holidays music will be allowed. This is a family event with children. Ask parade inspectors to verify music. (Initial ___)
- 9. Children and adults are not allowed to ride on the hood or sidestep of any vehicle. Any entry violating this rule will be immediately removed. (Initial ___)
- 10. A map will be provided for all parade entrants. Please follow all directions that are provided. It is your responsibility to pass all necessary information on to all of your participants. (Initial ___)
- 11. Please designate a spot (other than the parade line-up) to meet before and after the parade. Please have all parents meet at a pre-designated location to pick up their children. Please determine your group's "pick-up spot" ahead of time. An adult must supervise all children participating in the parade at all times. Parents with baby carriages and additional siblings in tow are not allowed, unless part of the entry and totally lit. (Initial ___)
- 12. The order of the parade will be provided at the mandatory meeting. A parade number will be assigned for each vehicle you enter in the parade. This number must be displayed on the upper right side of your vehicle(s), float(s), or banner. The entries name must be displayed visibly on the front of their parade entry for the crowd and media to see. You will not be able to get into the parade lineup without a number. (Initial ___)
- 13. Every year, it is a tradition for the City of El Paso Parks and Recreation Department to provide "Santa Claus" for the parade. For this reason, we are requesting that no other organization/company have a Santa Claus in the parade. Please be sure to communicate these rules and regulations to your participants. You assume responsibility for participants, guests, and any individual participating in your entry. (Initial ___)
- 14. Parade staff (in safety vests) will be spaced throughout the parade route to assist participants with concerns and enforce rules and regulations. (Initial ___)
- 15. A fire extinguisher or dry chemical-all-purpose extinguisher is required. Extinguishers should be up to date, certified, and easily accessible to the driver. No smoking will be permitted on or near the floats. Decorations should be heat resistant, fire retardant/proof. The parade official and fire marshal will inspect prior to parade. (Initial ___)
- 16. Generators must be secured in vehicle/trailer and allow a"12" spacing between combustibles and generator. Must have plenty of gasoline to operate 3 to 4 hours. (Initial ___)
- 17. Only Parade vehicles are authorized into the staging zone. Please make proper plans to park personal vehicle (s) outside the staging perimeter. (Initial ___)
- 18. NEW STREETCAR Safety Protocol: Due to the new Streetcar rail in the downtown area, a SAFETY protocol will be established for the safety of participants and spectators. Entries with any kind of vehicle will be restricted to a **14 feet height** limit and all participants will be asked to depart the vehicles 50 feet before crossing rails. City staff then will walk everyone 50 feet beyond rails and only then will escorted participants be permitted to board vehicles again. This item will be discussed further in the upcoming mandatory training. There will be no exceptions to this protocol.
